# WOODLAND CREATURES SCULPTURE TRAIL



Visitors to Westmead Open Space will already be familiar with the beautiful wooden owl sculpture that greets visitors accessing our land from Westmead Open Space car park.

There are now 11 new sculptures in the same copse of woodland. The sculptures are the result of a competition we ran in 2019 for local children to design wooden sculptures to be realised into a Tree Sculpture Trail. There was a winning entry from every Chippenham primary school. The children's designs have been turned into a set of stunning sculptures by a very talented local sculptor, Ollie Adams, who carves the wood using a chain saw.
